

ANIMAL REPORT

For this quarter a great part of the Science grade will be the “Animal Report Research Project.” Each student is expected to select a preferred animal based on good information about it. It could be because it’s in the endangered species list, or because it’s benefit to human kind, or some important fact.

Students will be required to turn in at least 5 cards (5x8 inches each). Each card should reflect a different source of information. Sources can be books, encyclopedias, Internet sites or reference materials. Each card should have the following information:

Front of the card: Information and details of the animal

Back of the card: Source where information was found.

Students then will be expected to do a write up of at least 200 words describing all the information of the animal researched. If the report is typed up it will give 20% more value to the project.

The Research Project should have the following information:

Name of the animal (scientific name if possible too)

Size and weight of an adult.

Food and care.

Habitat.

Places in the world where it can be found

Write all about its babies.

What is the animal known for.

Discuss its characteristic behaviors

Include a picture, either a photocopy or a printout.
